7. How the result is announced?

8. Cut off mark for selection for the post?

For each post, Cut off mark will be fixed considering the number of posts, number of candidates applied etc based on the approved guidelines.

9. Which are the venues for written test for advertisements made by VSSC?

Third van anthapuram will be one of the Centre for written/Skill Test. Other examination Centres if required will be decided subject to turn out of applications received and administrative constraints.

10. What is the salary and other facilities available for newly recruited Scientist/Engineer-SC in VSSC?

In addition to Basic Pay Rs.56100/-+ Dearness Allowance (DA) at the prescribed rate, House Rent Allowance (HRA) and Transport Allowance (TA) are payable as per extant rules on the subject as applicable at Thiruvananthapuram. The employees will be governed by the New Pension Scheme. On normal days the number of visitors allowed is up to 2000 nos. and on RH 200 launch days the number allowed is up to 5000 Nos A visit to the space museum will take more than an hour. There will be regular film shows on all days. Special shows will be arranged for groups with not less than 40 visitors, on request. Sounding rockets are generally launched from TERLS on every third Wednesday at 11:45 hours (subject to change for technical reasons) for scientific purposes. Those who wish to witness the launch should be present at space museum before 10:30 hrs. The entry is allowed only for Indian nationals. The interested Indian nationals can apply online, maximum 3 months in advance. Online request will be processed only on working days The request can be for an individual, a group or for Educational Institution/Organizations.
